	In the event of any dispute involving the Association and an Owner, the Owner is invited and encouraged to meet with the Board of Directors to resolve the dispute informally and without the need for litigation. If the Owner requests to meet with the Board, the Board shall make a reasonable effort to comply with the Owner's request.  Nothing in this Policy shall be construed to require any specific form of alternative dispute resolution, such as mediation or arbitration, or require the parties to meet. Neither the Association nor the Owner waives any right to pursue whatever legal or other remedial actions available to either party.

## Fox Creek Farm Master Association, Inc. Board Policy and Procedures Statement

## **Decisions Upon Architectural and Landscaping Changes**

This statement of board policy is established pursuant to §38-33.3-302(3)(b), Colorado Revised Statutes.

- 1. **Control of Decisions.** Pursuant to Colorado law (referenced above) standards and procedures for association decisions concerning approval or denial of a member's application for architectural or landscaping modifications, changes or remodeling are contained in the declaration of covenants, conditions and restrictions for the association, and in the rules and regulations of the association.
- 2. **Decision Standard.** Decisions concerning approval or denial of a member's application for architectural or landscaping modifications, changes or remodeling, shall in all cases not be made by the association, the executive board, or any committee thereof, either arbitrarily or capriciously.
