The circular slide in the large park was replaced about two weeks ago. Two thousand dollars was saved on the installation over the estimate provided by the company which sold us the slide.

The North Pump Station was finished about two months ago and is doing great. The cost for everything was about eighty-seven thousand dollars. The remaining funds from the loan, about thirteen thousand dollars, was returned back to the bank to pay down the principle. The landscaping on the island should be finished soon.

The Summer BBQ is planned for Saturday, June 29th, 4 pm to 6 pm, hopefully we do not need a back-up. We are going back to having a jumper instead of the large inflatable slide. The face painter will be there and we will have a snow cone machine this year. We hope to see everyone.
